Track 06: Sustainable Development Education at the edge of the Anthropocene

In the verge of the climate crisis, Higher Education Institutions (HEI) are in the middle of a struggle: from one point of view, they are somehow accountable for the perpetuating business as usual model standing in the companies, from another perspective they're paramount agents for turning the tide in direction of a more responsible and sustainable approach.

There can be no responsible companies without responsible leadership. This track aims to foster the debate upon the theoretical and empirical gaps yet to bridge upon rhetoric and practice in HEIs. In order to do so, we aim to answer one or more of the following questions:

- How does Higher Education Institutions walk their talk in the Sustainable Development Education?
- How does the Sustainable Development Goals(SDG) can be fostered by higher and/or business education?
- How can curricular changes and experiences can foster SDE?
- How does the interaction with society, government and companies can help integrate the SD into HEI?
- How informal curricular activities can foster SDE?
- What methodologies, practices and educational approaches are capable of promoting a collaborative learning milieu in the HEi?
- How can campus management structures impact the integration of SD?
- How does HEIs dialogue with environmental institutional pressures for an SD integration?

This is a non-exclusive list of questions that may guide your submission. The main perspective of the track is to approach the way HEI is dealing with the challenges posit by the complex and urgent demands of the Sustainable Development Agenda.

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
